- From the Greek word "LUTROTES" which means liberator or deliverer.


Why do need to be redeemed? "For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God." Romans 3:23

UNDERSTANDING THE PASSOVER

THE LAMB - JESUS CHRIST

5 Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male a year old. You may take it from the sheep or from the goats, 6 and you shall keep it until the fourteenth day of this month, when the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel shall kill their lambs at twilight.

EXODUS 12:5

The next day he saw Jesus coming to him and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!

JOHN 1:29

THE BLOOD - THE CROSS

"Then they shall take some of the blood and put it on the two doorposts and the lintel of the houses in which they eat it.

EXODUS 12:7

In fact, the law requires that nearly everything be cleansed with blood, and without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness.

HEBREWS 9:22

THE UNLEAVENED BREAD - YOU

And you shall observe the Feast of Unleavened Bread, for on this very day I brought your hosts out of the land of Egypt. Therefore you shall observe this day, throughout your generations, as a statute forever.

EXODUS 12:17

Exodus 6:6-8

7 I will take you to be my people, and I will be your God, and you shall know that I am the Lord your God, who has brought you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians.

8 I will bring you into the land that I swore to give to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob. I will give it to you for a possession. I am the Lord."
