MEDIATOR?

The word mediator in Gk: mesités: an arbitrator, a mediator: intervenes to restore peace between two parties, literally means a middle person. In other words someone who stands between two parties who are in dispute to bring them together; to bridge the gap, to re-establish peace — a sort of a peace-maker





Genesis 3:22-24 ESV

I.JESUS is the GREAT High Priest

Hebrews 4:14 ESV

Hebrews 7:26-27 ESV

²⁶ For it was indeed fitting that we should have such a high priest, holy, innocent, unstained, separated from sinners, and exalted above the heavens. ²⁷ He has no need, like those high priests, to offer sacrifices daily, first for his own sins and then for those of the people, since he did this once for all when he offered up himself.



2. JESUS is ABLÉ to SYMPATHIZE with US

Hebrews 4:15 ESV


For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin.

To sympathize (Greek, sumpatheo) means to commiserate (to feel or express sympathy), have compassion, be touched with a feeling of, or to be affected with the same feeling as another.

In Greek = "astheneia" weakness, frailty = disease, infirmity, sickness, weakness; which carries the meaning of properly without strength; ("weakness, sickness") refers to an ailment that deprives someone of enjoying or accomplishing what they would like to do;

The word "confidence" in Greek "parrésia: freedom of speech, confidence"

The word "mercy" in Greek

"eleos" = mercy, pity,

compassion

Hebrews 9:13-15 ESV

13 The blood of goats and bulls and the ashes of a heifer sprinkled on those who are ceremonially unclean sanctify them so that they are outwardly clean. 14 How much more, then, will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself unblemished to God, cleanse our consciences from acts that lead to death, so that we may serve the living God! 15 For this reason Christ is the mediator of a new covenant, that those who are called may receive the promised eternal inheritance-now that he has died as a ransom to set them free from the sins committed under the first covenant.
