Part I : 1 Kings 17:1-6



I Kings 17:1-6 NIV

Now **Elijah** the Tishbite, from Tishbe¹ in Gilead, said to Ahab, “As the Lord, the God of Israel, lives, whom I serve, there will be neither dew nor rain in the next few years except at my word.”² Then the word of the Lord came to Elijah: ³“Leave here, turn eastward and hide in the Kerith Ravine, east of the Jordan.

I. GOD IS ABLE TO PROVIDE IN THE MOST **UNLIKELY PLACE**



I Kings 17:2-3 ESV

*And the word of the Lord came to him: “Depart from here and **turn eastward** and hide yourself by **the brook** Cherith, which is **east of the Jordan**.*

WEST = PROVISION

EAST = DESOLATION







2. GOD IS ABLE TO PROVIDE IN THE
MOST **UNEXPECTED MANNER**

I Kings 17:4-5 ESV

*⁴You shall drink from **the brook**, and I have commanded **the ravens to feed you there.**⁵ So he went and did according to the word of the Lord. **He went and lived by the brook** Cherith that is east of the Jordan.*







3. GOD IS ABLE TO PROVIDE IN THE
MOST **EXTRAVAGANT MEASURE**

I Kings 17:6 ESV

*And **the ravens** brought him **bread and meat** in the **morning**, and **bread and meat in the evening**, and he drank from **the brook**.*
