



An annual membership allows the children to check out and enjoy books, learn to appreciate the library and its books and develop a sense of ownership in the program. Since November 2007, the MLP has provided access to books to over 126,100 children and mothers, 3,640 of whom have become permanent registered library members.



Since 2010, the Integrated Health Programme (IHP) continues to provide various public health and hygiene initiatives to many schools, clinics, and communities through the training and educating of mothers, children, teachers and nurses.

IHP has so far provided integrated health services to 6,520 primary schools, 174 community health centers and maternal-child healty health officers, 320,660 children, and helped train 31,200 health officers, teachers and mothers.



ISP forms deep, long-term relationships with partner schools, which are selected from applicants with whom YE's Outreach Programme has existing relationships. ISP then tailors the program to meet the needs of the schools and the educators who work within them. The program takes teachers where they are and engages them in a process of experiential learning, reflection, and the application of contemporary educational research within their school contexts. All of the ISP trainers are international (SPK) school teachers and International Baccalaureate (IB) workshop trainers. Since 2010, 134 schools and 835 teachers and principals have graduated from the program with a 86% graduation rate and a teaching annual impact of over 49,400 students per year.







- 2010 Establishment of the Integrated Health Programme (IHP) to focus on training and capacity-building for students, teachers and village clinic coordinators in Jakarta;
- 2011 Establishment of the Individuals with Disabilities Education and Assistance (IDEA) programme to provide deeper and long-term support for students and individuals with disabilities and special needs in DKI Jakarta and throughout West Java;
- 2012 MLP begins its collaboration and support of a home for neglected senior citizens over 52,000 children and mothers visit and participate in the library;
- 2013 IDEA creates One World, the first ever expo event for individuals with disabilities and special needs in Indonesia; FRP rescues and delivers over 250 tons of food;
- 2014 FRP over 1 million food beneficiaries.
- 2015 MLP over 100,000 children and mothers visit and participate in the library;
- 2016 ISP over 200 graduates; MLP over 3,000 library members;
- 2017 NEP Joy Schools Programme initiative launched in primary schools in Jakarta to provide regular access to proper nutrition while nurturing organic school gardens and education; FRPrescues and delivers over 400 tons of food; ISP over 60 schools complete the programme
- 2018 FRP over 1.5 million food beneficiaries. ISP over 600 graduates.
- 2019 ISP over 130 schools complete the programme with over 49,500 students impacted annually annual capacity is increased to 360 per incoming class.

Brief History

- 2000 Emmanuel Foundation (Yayasan Emmanuel) founded and the Immanuel Orphanage Home (PAI) is created in Bogor, West Java, Indonesia.
- 2001 Establishment of the Educational Outreach Programme (OP) in the Bogor and Greater Bogor area for 7 scholarship recipients.
- 2002 Establishment of the Nicolas Orphanage Home (PAN); OP serves the DKI Jakarta area, first annual
 Outreach Gathering OP scholarship recipients total 100.
- 2003 Establishment of the Health Services Programme (HSP) and the Food Rescue Programme (FRP) in Jakarta for 2 scavenger communities; first graduates from PAI pursue further education and careers; OP serves the Sukabumi and Bandung areas OP scholarship recipients total 450.
- 2004 Establishment of the Water Programme (WP) in Jakarta; HSP and FRP first quarterly "Baksos" initiative 12 scavenger communities are served; OP scholarship recipients total 620.
- 2005 Consolidation of the 6 programmes into 2 divisions: Education and Homes & Community Services (HCSD); strengthening of the foundation and its constituents; HCSD focuses on 6 core communities; FRP over 100,000 food beneficiaries: OP scholarship recipients total 1,472.
