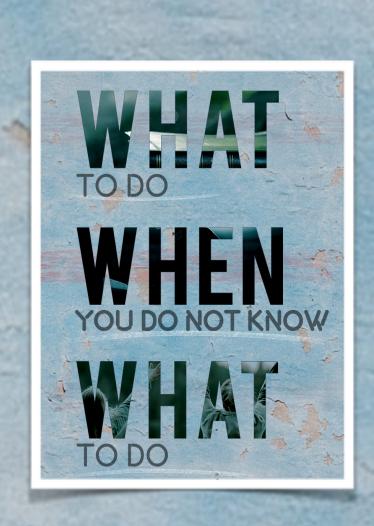






WHAT IS WISDOM?

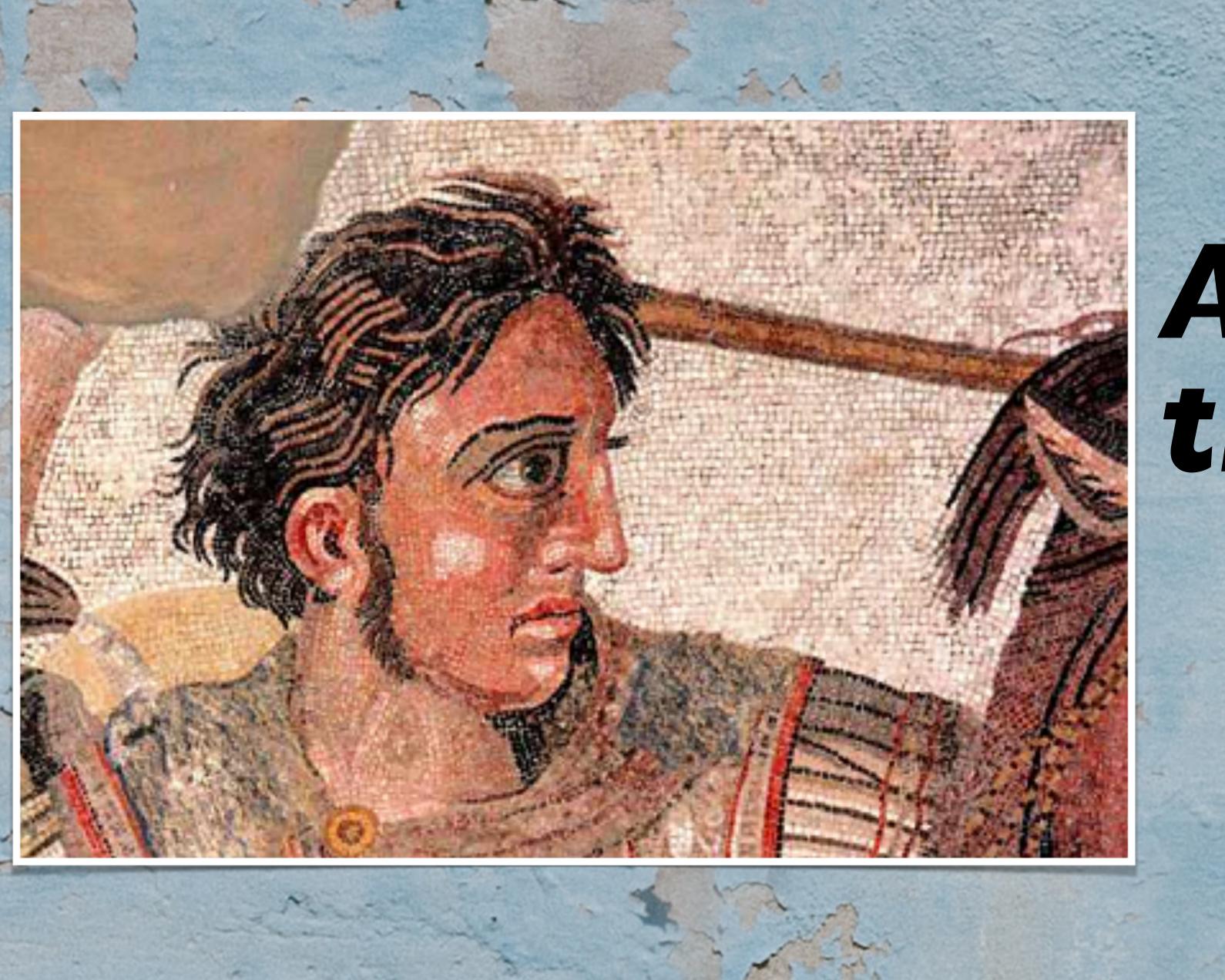


The World's Angriest Countries

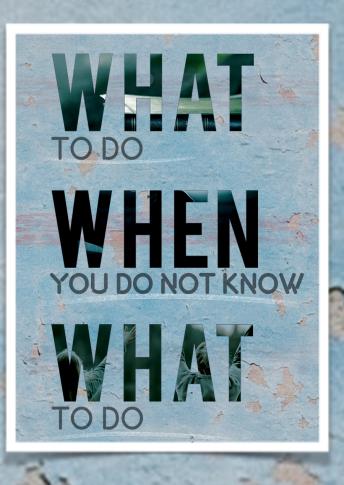
Share of the population that experienced a lot of anger yesterday (2018)*

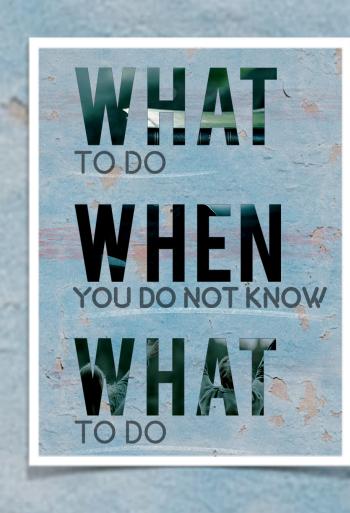


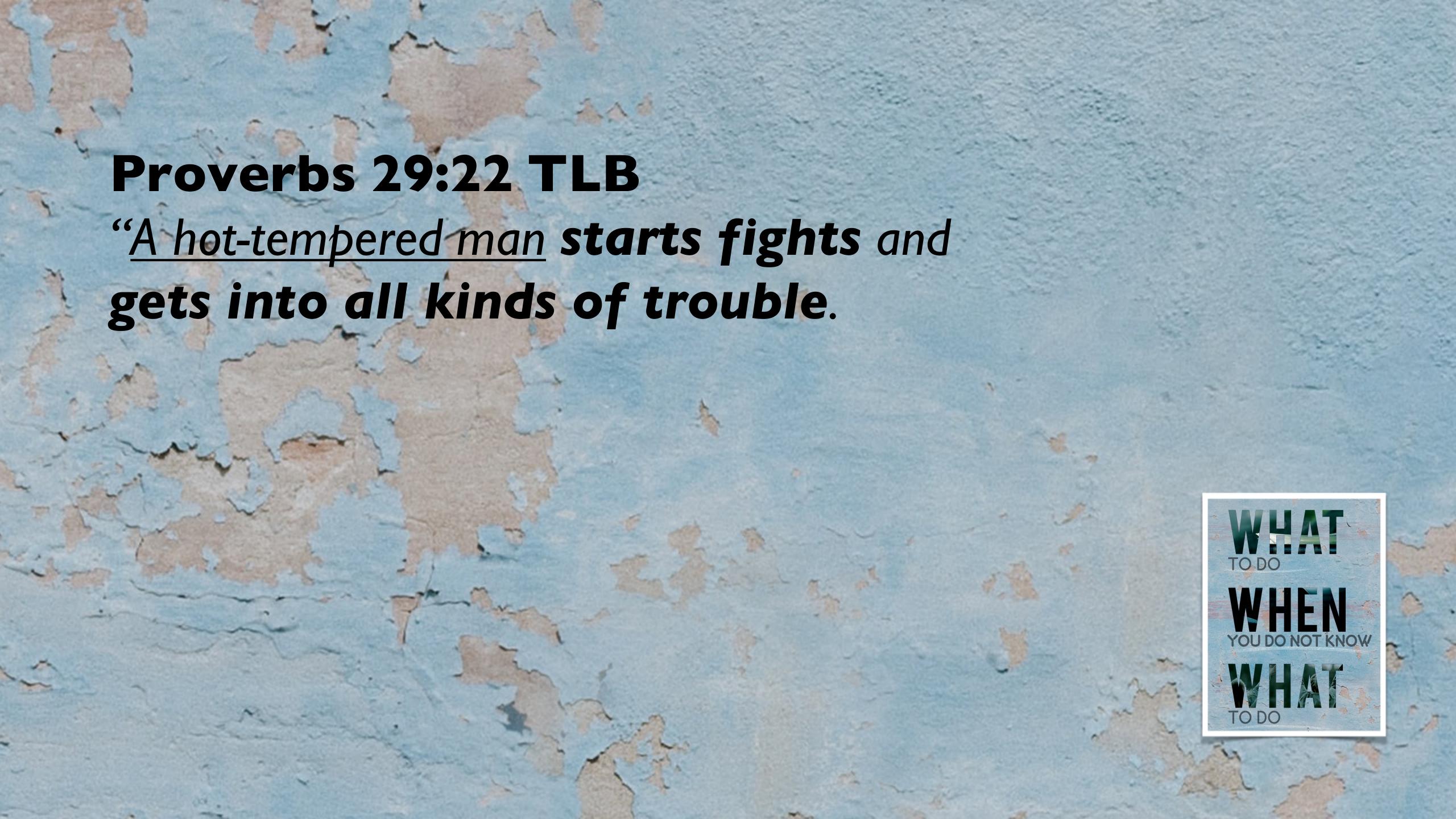

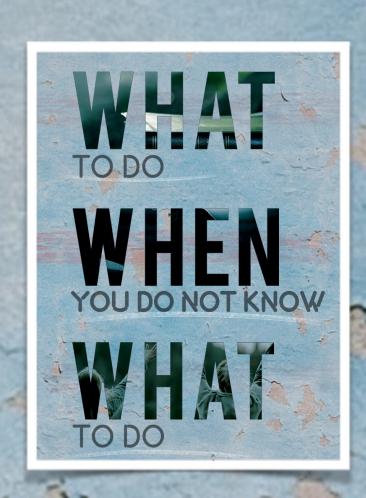




Proverbs 15:18 GNT

"Hot tempers cause arguments, but patience brings peace."

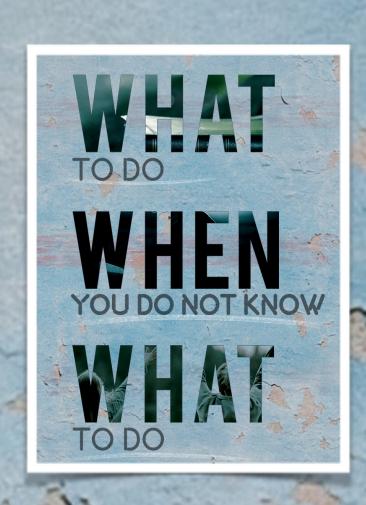
TLB: "A quick-tempered man starts fights; a cool-tempered man tries to stop them."

"A wise man controls his temper. He knows that anger causes mistakes."

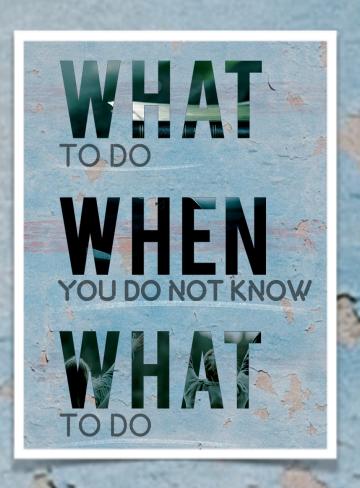
GNT: "If you stay calm, you are wise, but if you have a hot temper, you only show how stupid you are."



Proverbs 14:17 GNT

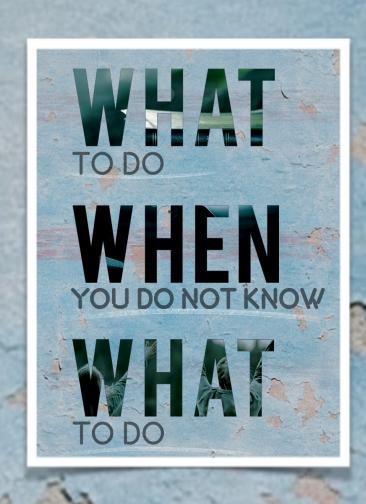
"People with a hot temper do foolish things; wiser people remain calm

TLB: "A short-tempered man is a fool. He hates the man who is patient."





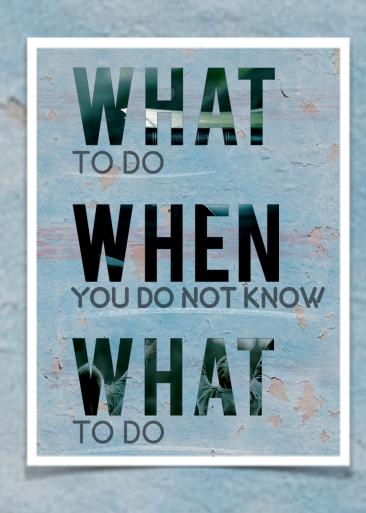
"The fool who provokes his family to anger and resentment will finally have nothing worthwhile left. He shall be the servant of a wiser man.





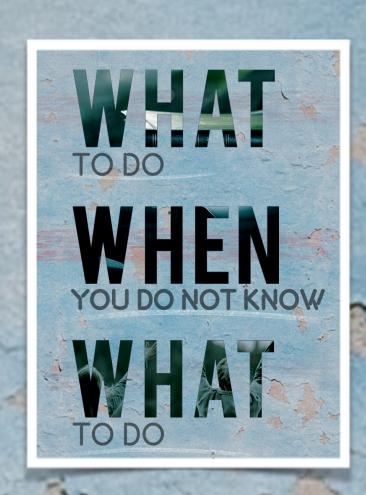


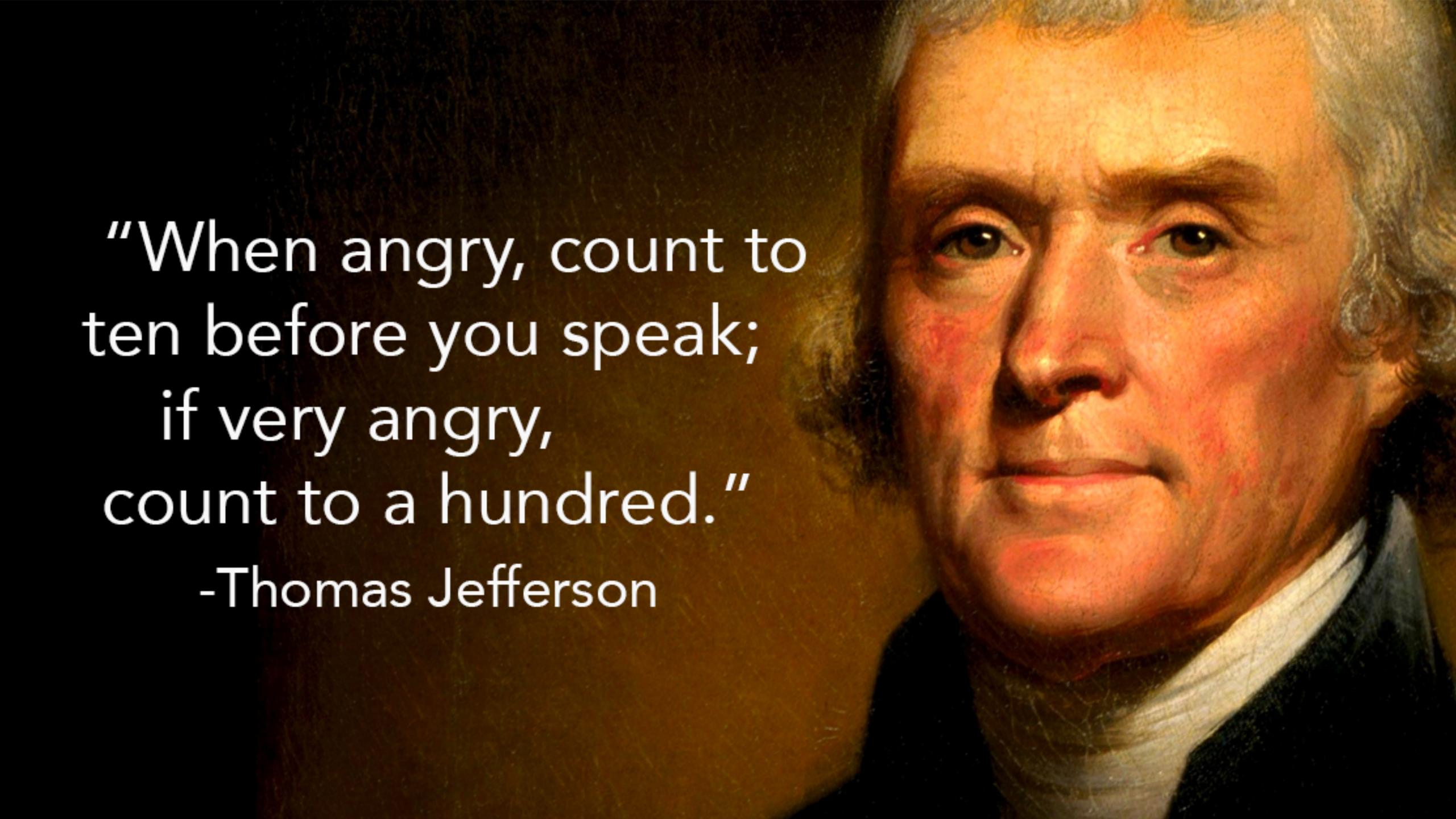
2.REFLECT Before Reacting

If the person is Equal to you.. count upto 30 and talk..

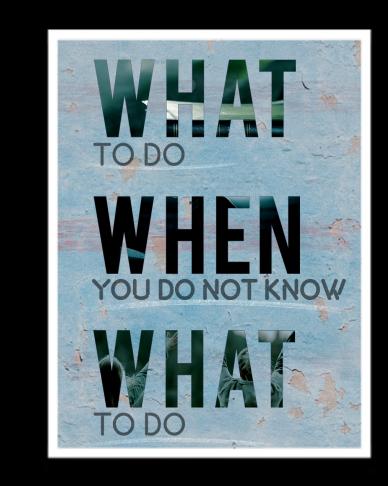
the person is Your senior to you then count 50, then talk..

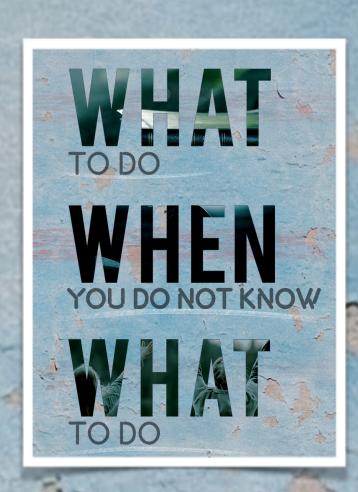
Proverbs 12:16 TLB

GNT:

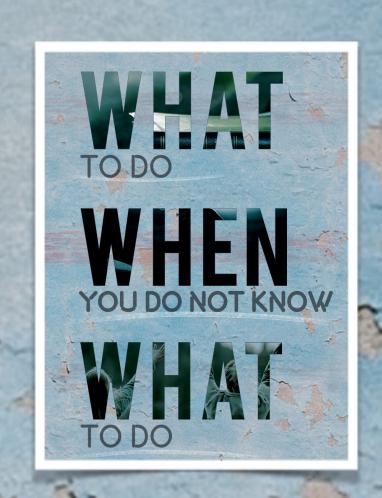
"When a fool is annoyed, he quickly lets it be known.

Icebergs are large pieces of ice found floating in the open ocean. What you can see from the surface can be misleading. Most of the iceberg is hidden below the water.

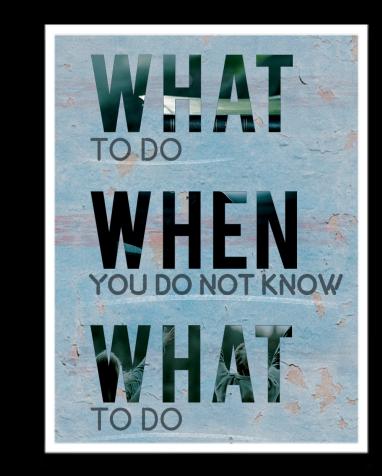

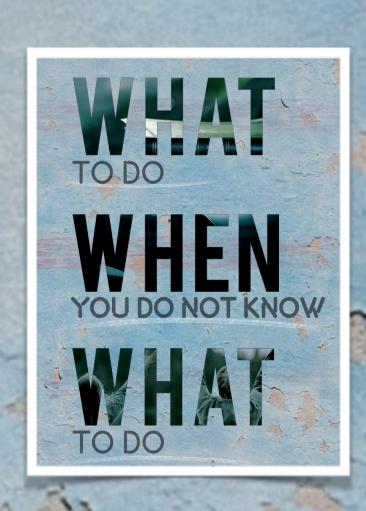
3.RESTRAIN Your Remarks



Proverbs 21:23 TLB

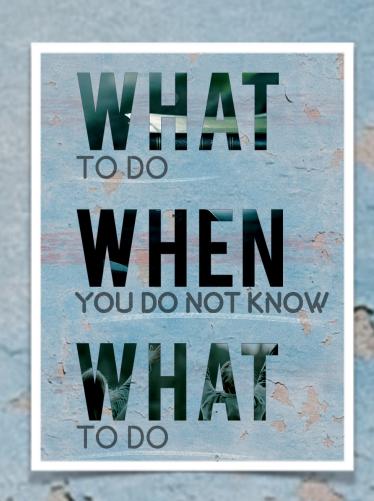
"Whoever keeps his mouth and his tongue, keeps himself out of trouble."

but a harsh word stirs up anger.

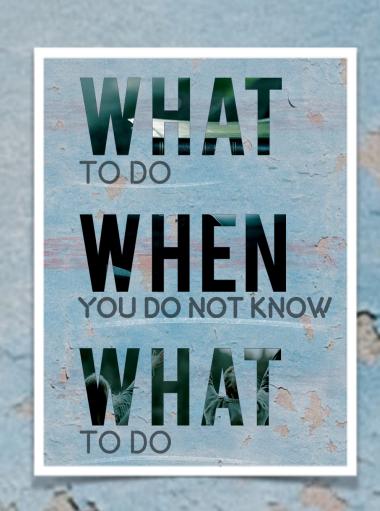
GNT: "A gentle answer quiets anger, but a harsh one stirs it up.



Proverbs 22:24-25 ESV

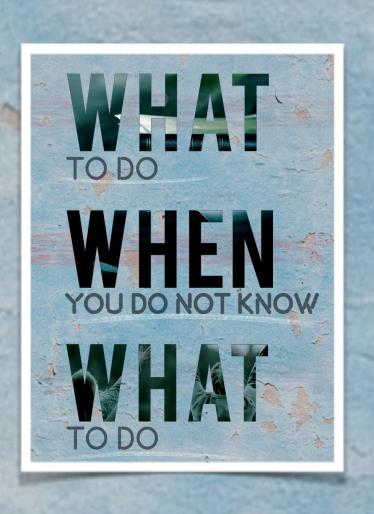
24 Make no friendship with a man given to anger, nor go with a wrathful man, 25 **lest you learn his ways** and entangle yourself in a snare.
