

Romans 1:18 NIV

2 Timothy 3:1-4 ESV


*But understand this, that **in the last days** there will come times of difficulty.*

Luke 17:11-19

Luke 17:11-19 ESV

¹¹On the way to Jerusalem he was passing along between Samaria and Galilee. ¹²And as **he entered a village**, he was met by **ten lepers**, who **stood at a distance** ¹³and **lifted up their voices**, saying, **“Jesus, Master, have mercy on us.”** ¹
⁴When **he saw them** he said to them, “Go and show yourselves to the priests.” **And as they went they were cleansed.**

Luke 17:15-19 ESV

¹⁵ Then **one** of them, when he saw that he was healed, turned back, **praising** God with a loud voice; ¹⁶ and he fell on his face at Jesus' feet, **giving him thanks**.

Now he was a Samaritan. ¹⁷ Then Jesus answered, "Were not **ten** cleansed? **Where are the nine?**

¹⁸ Was no one found to return and give praise to God except this foreigner?" ¹⁹ And he said to him, "Rise and go your way; **your faith has made you well.**"

The Story of Daniel Praying



Daniel 6

Daniel 6:1-5 ESV

*It pleased **Darius** to set over the kingdom 120 satraps, to be throughout the whole kingdom; ²and over them three high officials, of whom **Daniel** was one, to whom these satraps should give account, so that the king might suffer no loss. ³Then this **Daniel** became **distinguished** above all the other high officials and satraps, because an **excellent** spirit was in him. And the king planned to set him over the whole kingdom.*

Daniel 6:4-5 ESV

*4 Then the high officials and the satraps sought to find a ground for **complaint against Daniel** with regard to the kingdom, but they could find no ground for complaint or any fault, **because he was faithful**, and **no error or fault** was found in him. 5 Then these men said, “We shall not find any ground for complaint against this Daniel unless we find it in connection with the law of his God.”*

Daniel 6:10 ESV

¹⁰ *When **Daniel knew** that the document had been signed, he **went** to his house where he had **windows** in his upper chamber open toward Jerusalem. He got down on his knees **three times a day** and **prayed and gave thanks** before his God, **as he had done previously.***

Daniel 6:16-24 ESV

¹⁶ ***Then the king commanded, and Daniel was brought and cast into the den of lions. The king declared to Daniel, “May your God, whom you serve continually, deliver you!”*** ¹⁷ *And a stone was brought and laid on the mouth of the den, and the king sealed it with his own signet and with the signet of his lords, that nothing might be changed concerning Daniel.*

Daniel 6:18-24 ESV

¹⁸ *Then the king went to his palace and
spent the night fasting;
no diversions were brought to him, and
sleep fled from him.*

Daniel 6:19-24 ESV

¹⁹ ***Then, at break of day,*** the king arose and went in haste to the den of lions. ²⁰ *As he came near to the den where Daniel was, he cried out in a tone of anguish. The king declared to Daniel, “**O Daniel, servant of the living God,** has your God, whom you serve continually, been able to deliver you from the lions?”*

Daniel 6:21-24 ESV

²¹***Then Daniel** said to the king, “O king, live forever! ²²My God sent his angel and shut the lions' mouths, and they have not harmed me, because I was found blameless before him; and also before you, O king, I have done no harm.”*

Daniel 6:23-24 ESV

²³ ***Then the king*** was exceedingly glad, and commanded that Daniel be taken up out of the den. So Daniel was taken up out of the den, and no kind of harm was found on him, because he had trusted in his God.

Daniel 6:24 ESV

²⁴*And the king commanded, and those men who had maliciously accused Daniel were brought and cast into the den of lions—they, their children, and their wives. And before they reached the bottom of the den, the lions overpowered them and broke all their bones in pieces.*
