



PART 2: GENESIS 12 & 21








Genesis 12:1-3 ESV






GOD'S PROMISES TO ABRAM 1. I WILL SHOW YOU THE LAND 2. I WILL MAKE YOU A GREAT NATION 3. I WILL PROTECT YOU

IT SEEMS LIKE EVERY TIME A PROMISE IS GIVEN THERE IS A PROBLEM

1.God Promised that He will SHOW Abram the LAND: BUT there was FAMINIE in the land





Psalm 73:1-3 NLT

1 Truly God is good to Israel, to those whose hearts are pure. 2 But as for me, I almost lost my footing. My feet were slipping, and I was almost gone. 3 For I envied the proud when I saw them prosper despite their wickedness.

Psalm 73:4-5 & 12 NLT

4 They seem to live such painless lives; their bodies are so healthy and strong. 5 They don't have troubles like other people; they're not plagued with problems like everyone else.

12 Look at these wicked people— enjoying a life of ease while their riches multiply

Psalm 73:16-17 NLT

- 16 So I tried to understand why the wicked prosper.
- But what a difficult task it is!
- 17 Then I went into your sanctuary, O God, and I finally understood the destiny of the wicked.

2.God Promised that He will MAKE Abram A Great Nation: BUT Sarai was Barren

Genesis 11:29-30 ESV

"And Abram and Nahor took wives. **The name of Abram's wife was Sarai,** and the name of Nahor's wife,
Milcah, the daughter of Haran the father of Milcah and
Iscah. "Now **Sarai was barren; she had no child.**

Genesis 25:21a ESV

And Isaac prayed to the Lord for his wife, because she was barren.

NLT Isaac pleaded with the Lord on behalf of his wife, because she was unable to have children.

Genesis 29:31 ESV

When the Lord saw that Leah was hated, he opened her womb, but Rachel was barren."

3.God Promised that He will PROTECT Abram: BUT there were Enemies

Genesis 15:1 ESV

After these things the word of the Lord came to Abram in a vision: "Fear not, Abram, I am your shield; your reward shall be very great."

Genesis 14:8-9 & 12 ESV

Then the king of Sodom, the king of Gomorrah, the king of Admah, the king of Zeboiim, and the king of Bela (that is, Zoar) went out, and they joined battle in the Valley of Siddim with Chedorlaomer king of Elam, Tidal king of Goiim, Amraphel king of Shinar, and Arioch king of Ellasar, four kings against five.

"They also captured Lot—Abram's nephew who lived in Sodom—and carried off everything he owned.

3 Lessons

1. FAITH REQUIRES OBEDIENCE EVEN WHEN YOU DO NOT UNDERSTAND IT

Genesis 12:1 ESV
Now the Lord said to Abram, "Go
from your country and your kindred
and your father's house to the land that
I will show you.

Genesis 12:4-5 ESV

So Abram went, as the Lord had told him, and Lot went with him. Abram was seventy-five years old when he departed from Haran. And Abram took Sarai his wife, and Lot his brother's son, and all their possessions that they had gathered, and the people that they had acquired in Haran, and they set out to go to the land of Canaan.

WHEN GOD SAYS IT, HE WILL DO WHAT HE SAYS!

2. FAITH REQUIRES BELIEVING EVEN WHEN YOU DON'T SEE IT

Genesis 12:2 ESV
And I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you and make your name great, so that you will be a blessing.

Genesis 21:1-3 ESV

The Lord visited Sarah as he had said, and the Lord did to Sarah as he had promised. And Sarah conceived and bore Abraham a son in his old age at the time of which God had spoken to him. Abraham called the name of his son who was born to him, whom Sarah bore him, Isaac.

Genesis 25:21 ESV

Now Isaac pleaded with the Lord for his wife, because she was barren; and the Lord granted his plea, and Rebekah his wife conceived.

Genesis 30:22-23 ESV

"Then God remembered Rachel, and God listened to her and opened her womb. "And she conceived and bore a son, and said, "God has taken away my reproach."

WHEN GOD PROMISES, HE WILL ALWAYS KEEP HIS PROMISES.

3. FAITH REQUIRES TRUSTING EVEN WHEN YOU DO NOT KNOW WHEN

Genesis 21:1-5 ESV

Abraham was a hundred years old when his son Isaac was born to him. And Sarah said, "God has made laughter for me; everyone who hears will laugh over me." And she said, "Who would have said to Abraham that Sarah would nurse children? Yet I have borne him a son in his old age."

Genesis 25:19-21 ESV

"These are the generations of Isaac, Abraham's son: Abraham fathered Isaac, "and Isaac was forty years old when he took Rebekah, the daughter of Bethuel the Aramean of Paddan-aram, the sister of Laban the Aramean, to be his wife. And Isaac prayed to the Lord for his wife, because she was barren. And the Lord granted his prayer, and Rebekah his wife conceived.

Genesis 25:24-26 ESV

"When her days to give birth were completed, behold, there were twins in her womb. "The first came out red, all his body like a hairy cloak, so they called his name Esau. "Afterward his brother came out with his hand holding Esau's heel, so his name was called Jacob. Isaac was sixty years old when she bore them.
