





Genesis 22:1-19

I Now it came to pass after these things that God tested Abraham, and said to him, "Abraham!"
And he said, "Here I am."

² Then He said, "Take now your son, **your only son** Isaac, whom **you love**, and go to the land of Moriah, and offer him there as a **burnt offering** on one of the mountains of which I shall tell you."

Genesis 22:1-19 NKJV



3 So Abraham rose early in the morning and saddled his donkey, and took two of his young men with him, and Isaac his son; and he split the wood for the burnt offering, and arose and went to the place of which God had told him.

⁴ Then on the **third day** Abraham lifted his eyes and saw the place afar off.

And Abraham said to his young men, "Stay here with the donkey; the lad and I will go yonder and worship, and we will come back to you."

Similarities between the Story of Abraham's Faith Confirmed and the Gospel of Jesus Christ:-


