Why?

Hosea 4:1-2 NKJV

- Hear the word of the LORD,
 You children of Israel,
 For the LORD *brings* a charge against the inhabitants of the land:
 "There is no truth or mercy
 Or knowledge of God in the land.
- ² By swearing and lying, Killing and stealing and committing adultery, They break all restraint, With bloodshed upon bloodshed.

Hosea 4:3-5 NKJV

- Therefore the land will mourn;
 And everyone who dwells there will waste away
 With the beasts of the field
 And the birds of the air;
 Even the fish of the sea will be taken away.
- ⁴ "Now let no man contend, or rebuke another; For your people *are* like those who contend with the priest.
- Therefore you shall stumble in the day;
 The prophet also shall stumble with you in the night;
 And I will destroy your mother.

Hosea 4:6-8 NKJV

- ⁶ My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge. Because you have rejected knowledge, I also will reject you from being priest for Me; Because you have forgotten the law of your God, I also will forget your children.
- The more they increased,
 The more they sinned against Me;
 I will change their glory into shame.
- 8 They eat up the sin of My people; They set their heart on their iniquity.

Hosea 4:9-10 NKJV

⁹ And it shall be: like people, like priest.
So I will punish them for their ways,
And reward them for their deeds.
¹⁰ For they shall eat, but not have enough;
They shall commit harlotry, but not increase;
Because they have ceased obeying the LORD.

Matthew 7:1-3 NKJV

"Judge not, that you be not judged. ² For with what judgment you judge, you will be judged; and with the measure you use, it will be measured back to you. ³ And why do you look at the speck in your brother's eye, but do not consider the plank in your own eye?

Romans 12:19-21 NKJV

¹⁹ Beloved, do not avenge yourselves, but *rather* give place to wrath; for it is written, "Vengeance *is* Mine, I will repay," says the Lord. ²⁰ Therefore

"If your enemy is hungry, feed him;

If he is thirsty, give him a drink;

For in so doing you will heap coals of fire on his head."
