


Objectives:


Jesus is going back to the Father.

Jesus wants us to have peace, knowing that this world is filled with trouble.







Jesus is praying for His disciples.









Definition




Sanctify = sept apart for special use

Have you set apart yourself from this world or still living among it?




Acts 26:16-18
