- 9 And immediately the man was made well, took up his bed, and walked. And that day was the Sabbath.






John 5:1-2 (NKJV)

POINT 1:

Reflect on Your Condition



JOHN 5:3-5 (NKJV)

- ³ In these lay a great multitude of sick people, blind, lame, paralyzed, waiting for the moving of the water.
- ⁴ For an angel went down at a certain time into the pool and stirred up the water; then whoever stepped in first, after the stirring of the water, was made well of whatever disease he had.

 ⁵ Now a certain man was there who had an infirmity thirty-eight years.



JOHN 5:6,8 (NKJV)

When Jesus saw him lying there, and knew that he already had been in that condition a long time, He said to him, "Do you want to be made well?"
Jesus said to him, "Rise, take up your bed and walk."



Reflect on these questions:

- Are you someone who is still believing in the cultures that your forefathers had practiced before? (v.4)
- What is your current condition? Do you need a miracle? (v.3)
- How long have you been suffering and longing for a miracle? (v.5)
- Do you need healing, a breakthrough, a miracle in your life? (v.6)







Deuteronomy 2:14 NKJV

POINT 2:

Know the Real Miracle Giver



JOHN 5:6,8 (NKJV)

When Jesus saw him lying there, and knew that he already had been in that condition a long time, He said to him, "Do you want to be made well?"
Jesus said to him, "Rise, take up your bed and walk."



Jesus the Real Miracle Giver:

- o Jesus is a compassionate God. (v.5)
- Jesus knows the condition you are currently facing. (v.5)
- Jesus is asking you if you want to be well? (v.5)
- Jesus is the almighty God and is very capable to give you a miracle today! (v.8)



Receive God's Miracle Today



JOHN 5:9 (NKJV)

- ⁷The sick man answered Him, "Sir, I have no man to put me into the pool when the water is stirred up; but while I am coming, another steps down before me."

How do you receive Jesus miracle in your life?

- o Turn away from your old beliefs.
- Believe in Jesus Christ the real miracle giver. (v.8)
- o Obey the Lord. (v.9)



Continuously Receive God's Miracle



JOHN 5:12-14 (NKJV)

12 Then they asked him, "Who is the Man who said to you, 'Take up your bed and walk'?"

13 But the one who was healed did not know who it was, for Jesus had withdrawn, a multitude being in that place.

14 Afterward Jesus found him in the temple, and said to him, "See, you have been made well. Sin no more, lest a worse thing come upon you."



How do you receive Jesus miracle in your life?

Walk in complete obedience in the Lord. (v.14)

JOHN 5:15 (NKJV)

The man departed and told the Jews that it was Jesus who had made him well.




Testify your miracle for others to see Jesus
 Christ the real miracle giver. (v.15)




Why did Jesus make this miracle on this particular paralytic man?
