
Philippians 2:25-28 (NKJV)

- Yet I considered it necessary to send to you **Epaphroditus**, **my brother**, **fellow worker**, and **fellow soldier**, but your messenger and the one who ministered to my need;
- ²⁶ since he was longing for you all, and was distressed because you had heard that he was sick.
- 27 For indeed he was sick almost unto death; but God had mercy on him, and not only on him but on me also, lest I should have sorrow upon sorrow.
- ²⁸ Therefore I sent him the more eagerly, that when you see him again you may rejoice, and I may be less sorrowful.




Why was Epaphroditus praised by Paul?



BACKGROUND

- Paul is the author.
- **A pastoral letter to the Christians in Philippi.**
- Paul wrote it while in prison probably in Rome around A.D. 62.

- To tell them that Epaphroditus has recovered from a serious illness.
- **To encourage them in their faith.**
- To assure them he was still in good spirits.
- **To thank them for their continued support.**


