First Mear of Jesus' Ministry

- (John 2:1-12) Wedding at Cana
- (John 2:23) Many believe
- (John 3:22-36) Jesus baptizes disciples
- (Matt 4:23-25) Jesus ministers in Galilee and fame spreads to Syria

Second Mear of Jesus' Ministry

- (Matt 5-7) Sermon on the Mount
- (Matt 8:5-13) Healed the servant of a Roman centurion
- (Luke 7:12-16) Raised to life the widow's son in Nain
- (Mark 1:45; 3:7-10) Crowds pressed against Jesus

Third Mear of Jesus' Ministry

- (John 6:1-15) Feeding of 5,000
- (John 11:1-44) Raised Lazarus from the dead
- (John 12-19) Final week in Jerusalem


