FACTS: Jesus Appears after His Resurrection







MARY MAGDALENE

Mark 16:9-11

,[[Now when **he rose** early on the first day of the week, he appeared first to Mary Magdalene, from whom he had cast out seven demons. 10 She went and told those who had been with him, as they mourned and wept. 11 But when they heard that he was alive and had been seen by her, they would not believe it.



THE OTHER WOMEN RETURNING FROM THE TOMB

Matthew 28:8-10

⁵But the angel said to **the women**, "Do not be afraid, for I know that you seek Jesus who was crucified. 6He is not here, for he has risen, as he said. Come, see the place where he lay. 7Then go quickly and tell his disciples that he has risen from the dead, and behold, he is going before you to Galilee; there you will see **him**. See, I have told you."



THE OTHER WOMEN RETURNING FROM THE TOMB

Matthew 28:8-10

*So they **departed** quickly from the tomb with fear and great joy, and ran to tell his disciples. And behold, Jesus met them and said, "Greetings!" CLEOPAS & ANOTHER DISCIPLE ON THE ROAD TO EMMAUS

Luke 24:13-32 / Mark16:12-13

15 While they were talking and discussing together, Jesus himself drew near and went with them. 16 But their eyes were kept from recognizing him. 17 And he said to them, "What is this conversation that you are holding with each other as you walk?" And they stood still, looking sad. 18 Then one of them, named Cleopas, answered him, "Are you the only visitor to Jerusalem who does not know the things that have happened there in these days?"



APOSTLE PETER

Luke 24:33-35 / 1 Cor 15:5

33 And they rose that same hour and returned to Jerusalem. And they found the eleven and those who were with them gathered together, 34 saying, "The Lord has risen indeed, and has appeared to Simon!" 35 Then they told what had happened on the road, and how he was known to them in the breaking of the bread.



TO THE ELEVEN & OTHERS

Luke 24:36-49

36 As they were talking about these things, Jesus himself stood among them, and said to them, "Peace to you!" 37 But they were startled and frightened and thought they saw a spirit. 38 And he said to them, "Why are you troubled, and why do doubts arise in your hearts? 39 See my **hands and my feet**, that it is I myself. But he said to them, "Unless I see in his hands the mark of the nails, and place my finger into the mark of the nails, and place my hand into his side, I will never believe."


