

#1: THE STORY OF JEREMIAH

Jeremiah 36



² "Take a **scroll** and **write** on it all the words that I have **spoken** to you against Israel and Judah and all the nations, from the day I **spoke** to you, from the days of Josiah until today. ³ It may be that the house of Judah will **hear** all the disaster that I intend to do to them, so that every one may **turn** from his evil way, and that I may **forgive** their iniquity and their sin."

Jeremiah 36:2-3



4 Then Jeremiah called Baruch the son of Neriah, and Baruch wrote on a scroll at the dictation of Jeremiah all the words of the Lord that he had spoken to him. 5 And Jeremiah ordered Baruch, saying, "I am banned from going to the house of the Lord, so you are to go, and on a day of fasting in the hearing of all the people in the Lord's house you shall read the words of the Lord from the scroll that you have written at my dictation. #2: THE STORY OF MORDECAL

Esther 6



On that night the king could not sleep. And he gave orders to bring the book of memorable deeds, the chronicles, and they were read before the king. 2 And it was found written how Mordecai had told about Bigthana and Teresh, two of the king's eunuchs, who guarded the threshold, and who had sought to lay hands on King Ahasuerus. 3 And the king said, "What honor or distinction has been bestowed on Mordecai for this?" The king's young men who attended him said, "Nothing has been done for him."



#1: THE STORY OF JEREMIAH

Jeremiah 36



It may be that their **plea** for mercy will come before the Lord, and that every one will **turn** from his evil way, for great is the anger and wrath that the Lord has pronounced against this people." And Baruch the son of Neriah did all that Jeremiah the prophet ordered him about **reading** from the **scroll** the words of the Lord in the Lord's house.

And they said to Baruch, "We must report all these words to the king." 17 Then they asked Baruch, "Tell us, please, how did you write all these words? Was it at his dictation?" 18 Baruch answered them, "He dictated all these words to me, while I wrote them with ink on the scroll." 19 Then the officials said to Baruch, "Go and hide, you and Jeremiah, and let no one know where you are.

²⁰ So they went into the court to the king, having put the **scroll** in the chamber of Elishama the secretary, and they reported all the words to the king. ²¹ Then the king sent Jehudi to get the **scroll**, and he took it from the chamber of Elishama the secretary. And Jehudi **read** it to the king and all the officials who stood beside the king.

²² It was the ninth month, and the king was **sitting** in the winter house, and there was a fire burning in the fire pot before him. ²³ As Jehudi **read** three or four columns, **the king would cut** them off with a knife and **throw** them into the fire in the fire pot, until **the entire scroll** was consumed in the fire that was in the fire pot.

27 Now after the king had burned the scroll with the words that Baruch wrote at Jeremiah's dictation, the word of the Lord came to Jeremiah: 28 "Take another scroll and write on it all the former words that were in the first scroll, which Jehoiakim the king of Judah has burned.

32 Then Jeremiah took another scroll and gave it to Baruch the scribe, the son of Neriah, who wrote on it at the dictation of Jeremiah all the words of the scroll that Jehoiakim king of Judah had burned in the fire. And many similar words were added to them.



#3: THE STORY OF JESUS



Luke 4


#4: THE STORY OF THE ADULTEROUS WOMAN


