



Gk: "kakopatheo" from (kakos =

evil + pathos = passion):

enduring hardship;

V14: SICK:

Gk: Astheneó; = physical ailments often leading to death;

V15:SICK:

Gk: kamnó = distressed, weary to the point of sickness; mental/ emotional;

V15: SINS:

Gk: Hamartia =sin, wrong doing;




