Acts 2:40

Greek = "skolios," which means: Bent, crooked, not straight; Figuratively: morally wrong, corrupt, or warped;

- **Rejection** of the Messiah: They failed to recognize Jesus as the fulfilment of their own scriptures.
- **Moral** Corruption: There might have been a sense of spiritual and moral decline within the Jewish leadership at the time.
- Need for Salvation: Peter is urging them to repent and turn towards God to be saved from this spiritual crookedness.

Greek = "proskartereo"
which means:
has a stronger meaning than just casual
attention.;

- **Constantly** attending: Being present and engaged in a dedicated way.
- **Giving full** attention: Not just listening passively, but actively seeking understanding and applying the teachings.
- Clinging to: Holding firmly to the apostles' teaching, suggesting a deep commitment and belief in its importance.



#2: SPIRITUAL: V43

Acts 2:43

Greek = "ekstasis"
which means:
Astonishment, amazement, wonder,
overwhelmed by something powerful;

- Awesome **presence** of God: witnessing the extra-ordinary events caused by the Holy Spirit.
- A sense of **reverence** and respect: a deepening sense of reverence to God;
- A sense of the Extra-ordinary: a recognition of extra-ordinary events beyond human explanation;



RELATIONAL: V44-45

- Building relationships
 Fellowship & meeting needs
- Togetherness

Acts 2:44-45

44And all who believed were together and had all things in common. 45 And they were selling their possessions and belongings and distributing the proceeds to all, as any had need.

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Acts 2:44-45

- Greek = 'koinonia'
 The community of togetherness
- Building strong relationships within a faith community
- **Shared-experiences**: the early church likely spent time together beyond just worship services;
- Shared-life: "Breaking bread together": suggested a shared-meal as the central element of their togetherness; it goes beyond just food, it creates opportunities for conversation, laughter and building friendships;
- **Shared-compassion**; Having everything in common: the act of selflessness;

• The culture of ongoing outreach: continues missions: not a one-time task: added daily;
