## WHAT IS THE MEANING OF "MESSIAH"?





### "MESSIAH"

"Messiah" comes from the Hebrew Mashiach, meaning the "Anointed one."







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"Messiah" comes from the Hebrew Mashiach, meaning "Anointed one."

In Greek, the equivalent is Christos, from which we get "Christ."



### "CHRISTIAN" "CHRIST+IAN"



### "CHRISTIAN" "CHRIST+IAN"

CHRIST => "Messiah" => the "Anointed one."

+IAN => referring to the suffix used in Greek & Latin which means "belonging to" or "followers of"

Therefore,
CHRIST+IAN =>
A person belonging to
Christ or a follower of the
Messiah, or Christ or the
Anointed one.

#### 3-Are you IDENTIFYING with Christ?


• **Bearing** His name especially in times of persecution.



### WHO IS THE "MESSIAH"?



40 One of the two who **heard** John speak and **followed** Jesus was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother. 41 He first found his own brother Simon and said to him, "**We have found the Messiah**" (which means **Christ**). 42 He brought him to Jesus. Jesus looked at him and said, "You are Simon the son of John. You shall be called Cephas" (which means Peter).





### 66BELLEVE?

The Greek verb "pisteuó" primarily means to believe or to have faith; which goes beyond intellectual assent.

- It conveys a sense of trust and reliance upon someone or something.
- It means to place trust in or rely upon someone and to commit oneself fully in faith and relationship.

### WHAT DOES LIFE MEAN?

In John's Gospel, life (zoe) often refers to eternal life. This is not just an unending existence but a quality of life marked by the relationship with have with God.
