SYNAXY YAYAYAYAYAYAYAYAYAYAYA

- Before they arrived, an earth quake occurred & 1 angel rolled back the stone & sat on it (Matt 28:2-4)
- The women found the stone already moved & they arrived (Mark 16:4; Luke 24:2)
- The women entered the tomb & saw that Jesus' body was gone (Luke 24:3)
- 1 angel & 2 angels appeared to them, announcing that Jesus had risen (Matt 28;5-7; Mark 16:5-7, Luke 24:4-7)
- The women left the tomb, ran to disciples. (John 20:1-2)
- It was Mary Magdelene, Joanna, Mary (Mother of James) & a few more who told them that the body was missing





• Mary Magdalene, Peter & John ran to the tomb, saw the linen cloths but hadn't understood the Scriptures that Jesus must rise from the dead so they went home. (John 20:3-9)



Magdalene

- Mary Magdalene stayed outside the tomb, weeping.
- She saw 2 angels inside the tomb.
- Then she turned & she encountered Jesus (John 20:11-17)
- She was 1st to see Jesus (Mark 16:9)
- Jesus told her to go & tell the disciples He had risen (John 20:18)



- 1 angel & 2 angels appeared to them, announcing that Jesus had risen (Matt 28;5-7; Mark 16:5-7, Luke 24:4-7)
- Jesus appears to the other women left the tomb, Jesus appeared to them & repeated the instruction to tell the disciples (Matt 28:8-10)
- The women told the disciples what they had seen & heard but the disciples initially did not believe them (Luke 24:9-11; Mark 16:10-11)



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
