




4 Keys Action

## 1- GO: -THE CALL TO STEP OUT IN FAITH

Matthew 28:19a ... Go, therefore...

In Gk: GO = pore-u-o-mai: = to go, to proceed, to travel, to journey;

= physical movement from one place to another; It is NOT passive but ACTIVE! = Jesus didn't say "stay and wait..."

### WHY must we GO?

Matthew 28:19a ... Go, therefore...

### BECAUSE

1-Jesus **COMMANDED** it. =it is **not** optional but first priority; Matthew 28:18-20

2-People are **LOST** without Christ Romans 10:14-15

How then will they <u>call</u> on him in whom they have not believed? And how are they to <u>believe</u> in him of whom they have never heard? And how are they to <u>hear</u> without someone preaching?

And how are they to preach unless they are sent? As it is written, "How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the good news!"

## 2- MAKE DISCIPLES: -THE CALL TO MULTIPLY

Matthew 28:19b ... and make disciples of all nations...

In Gk : Disciples = mathé-teu-ó : =To make a disciple, to teach, to instruct;

=the process of **teaching** and **guiding** individuals to become followers of Jesus Christ; **shaping** the character and life of the learner to **align** with the teachings of Christ to be a disciple maker.

### WHY must we MAKE DISCIPLES?

Matthew 28:19b

... and make disciples of all nations...

### BECAUSE

1-Jesus MAKE DISCIPLES before sending them.

=Jesus didn't make converts/gather crowds;

2-The Church **EXISTS** to make disciples. =Is not just a gathering but a disciplemaking movements;

3-Discipleship TRANSFORMS lives. =It goes beyond accepting Christ; it is about learning, growing and obeying Jesus. ...and what you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses entrust to faithful men, who will be able to teach others also..

2 Timothy 2:2

## 3-BAPTIZE: -THE CALL TO PUBLIC DECLARATION

Matthew 28:19c

... baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit...

In Gk : Baptize = baptizó: = To baptize, to immerse, to dip

=baptism symbolizing purification, repentance, and the believer's identification with the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus Christ.

### WHY BAPTISM is important?

Matthew 28:19c ... baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit...

### **BECAUSE**

1-Jesus SET an example for us. Mark 1:9

2-It is an ACT of obedience. Acts 2:41, Acts 8:12 So those who received his word were baptized, and there were added that day about three thousand souls.

Acts 2:41

But when they **believed** Philip as he preached good news about the kingdom of God and the name of Jesus Christ, they were **baptized**, both men and women.

Acts 8:12

### WHY BAPTISM is important?

Matthew 28:19c

... baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit...

### BECAUSE

1-Jesus SET an example for us. Mark 1:9

2-It is an ACT of obedience. Acts 2:41, Acts 8:12

3-Through baptism, we IDENTIFY with Christ's death and resurrection.
Romans 6:3-4

Do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death?

We were **buried** therefore with him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was **raised** from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might **walk in newness of life**.

# 4- TEACH: -THE CALL TO ESTABLISH AND EQUIP IN FAITH

### Matthew 28:20

... teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.

In Gk : teaching = did-as-kó: =To teach, instruct, admonish;

=the act of **imparting** knowledge or skills, often in a formal or authoritative manner;

=It is NOT just transferring knowledge but is about transforming lives
