












Ask: When was the last time, you told of the story of your joy of salvation?

MIS-CONCEPTION OF JOY?

#1: JOY IS THE SAME AS HAPPINESS?

MIS-CONCEPTION OF JOY?

#2: I WILL HAVE JOY WHEN ALL MY PROBLEMS ARE GONE?

 Truth: Joy is not the absence of problems but having joy even when in the storms.



MIS-CONCEPTION OF JOY?

#3: I WILL HAVE JOY WHEN I SERVE IN A MINISTRY?

 Truth: Even pastors, leaders and workers can lose their joy if they serve without a real connection with Jesus.
