


Matthew 6:9-13







The Israelites in the Wilderness (Exodus 16:1-5)

"They set out from Elim, and all the congregation of the people of Israel came to the wilderness of Sin, which is between Elim and Sinai, on the fifteenth day of the second month after they had departed from the land of Egypt. ² And the whole congregation of the people of Israel grumbled against Moses and Aaron in the wilderness, 3 and the people of Israel said to them, "Would that we had died by the hand of the Lord in the land of Egypt, when we sat by the meat pots and ate bread to the full, for you have brought us out into this wilderness to kill this whole assembly with hunger."



The Israelites in the Wilderness

- Around 600,000 men, excluding women and children (Exodus 12:37).
- Not easy to manage they complained a lot!
- Between Exodus 1 and 16, they cried out, grumbled, and complained a lot!
 - While in Egypt, they complained about suffering and slavery.
 - Before crossing the Red Sea, they complained about Moses leading them out of Egypt to die.
 - After crossing the Red Sea, they complained about the bitter water at Marah.
 - Upon reaching the Wilderness of Sin, they complained about hunger.

#1 God Hears Us!


"And God heard their groaning..." – Exodus 2:24a






God hears every detail of our prayer clearly!
