Exodus 34:6 - And he passed in front of Moses, proclaiming,  
“The Lord, the Lord, the **compassionate** and gracious God,  
slow to anger, abounding in love and faithfulness

Psalms 145:8 - The Lord is gracious and **compassionate**,  
slow to anger and rich in love.

## ***EPHESIANS 2***

<sup>4</sup> But because of his great love for us, God, who is rich in mercy,  
<sup>5</sup> **made us alive with Christ** even when we were dead in  
transgressions—it is by grace you have been saved. <sup>6</sup> And God  
raised us up with Christ and seated us with him in the heavenly  
realms in Christ Jesus, <sup>7</sup> in order that in the coming ages he  
might show the incomparable riches of his grace, expressed in  
his kindness to us in Christ Jesus.

## ***ROMANS 6***

<sup>11</sup> In the same way, count yourselves **dead to sin but alive to God in Christ Jesus**. <sup>12</sup> Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body so that you obey its evil desires. <sup>13</sup> Do not offer any part of yourself to sin as an instrument of wickedness, but rather **offer yourselves to God** as those who have been **brought from death to life**; and **offer every part of yourself to him as an instrument of righteousness**. <sup>14</sup> For sin shall no longer be your master, because you are not under the law, but under grace.
