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PROMSE OF PEACE

"You keep him..." (v.3a)

The word "keep" in Hebrew = means to guard, to watch over, preserve, or protect — it's active, not passive.



PROMISE OF PEACE

You don't have to chase peace—you can rest in the One who keeps it.

God doesn't just give peace; He keeps you in peace.

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Isaiah 26:3-4

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THE NATURE OF PEACE

"In perfect peace..." (v.3b)

In Hebrew, the phrase is literally means "shalom shalom" — peace repeated twice.

"Perfect peace" (shalom shalom) means total well-being — emotional, spiritual, mental, and relational wholeness.

It's not just "I'm okay for now." It's "I'm steady no matter what."

NATURE OFPEACE

"Perfect peace" (shalom shalom): it means more than the absence of conflict: it means...

- Wholeness of being;
- Soundness of mind;
 Harmony in relationships;
- Rest in your spirit;



THE NATURE OF PEACE

God doesn't promise to take us out of the storm, but to bring us into the calm of His presence in the middle of it."

God's peace doesn't depend on what's happening around you but on who's reigning within you.

#3-(60) CALLS US TO EIX OUR MIND

Isaiah 26:3-4


"You keep him in perfect peace whose mind is stayed on you, because he trusts in you. Trust in the Lord forever, for the Lord God is an everlasting rock."

CONDITION OF PEACE

"whose mind is stayed on You..." (v.3c)

The Hebrew word for "stayed": "sawmak" means "to lean on, to rest upon, to be supported by."

It comes from the root "to prop," and has the idea "to lean upon or take hold of...bear up, establish, uphold, lay, lean, lie hard, put, rest self, set self, stand fast, stay (self), sustain."




OFPEACE

Peace comes when our mind leans fully on God's truth, not on our fears or what-ifs — not on the world, not on worry.

A mind that is stayed on God is:

• Anchored, not anxious.

- Focused, not fragmented.
- Trusting, not trembling.







CONDITION COFPEACE

Peace follows focus.

What you fix your mind on determines what fills your heart.

What your mind stays on determines whether you stand in peace or fall into pieces.

INVITES US TO TRUST COMPLETEL

Isaiah 26:3-4

"You keep him in perfect peace whose mind is stayed on you, because he trusts in you. Trust in the Lord forever, for the Lord God is an everlasting rock."

FOUNDATION OF PEACE

"... because he **trusts** in you. **Trust** in the Lord forever, for the Lord God is an everlasting rock."

(V3d-4)

OF PEACE The word "trust" (Heb : batach) means be bold confident, secure, sure, careless one, put confidence, make to hope, put.

CONDITION COFPEACE

Isaiah says, "Trust in the Lord forever, for the Lord God is an everlasting rock."

 That means He's solid, stable, unshakable — unlike this shifting world.



GOD IS THE KEEPER OF PEACE

OUR MIND IS THE <u>CARRIER</u> OF PEACE

"You keep him in perfect peace whose mind is stayed on you, because he trusts in you. Trust in the Lord forever, for the Lord God is an everlasting rock."

Isaiah 26:3-4
