Romans 12:2 ESV

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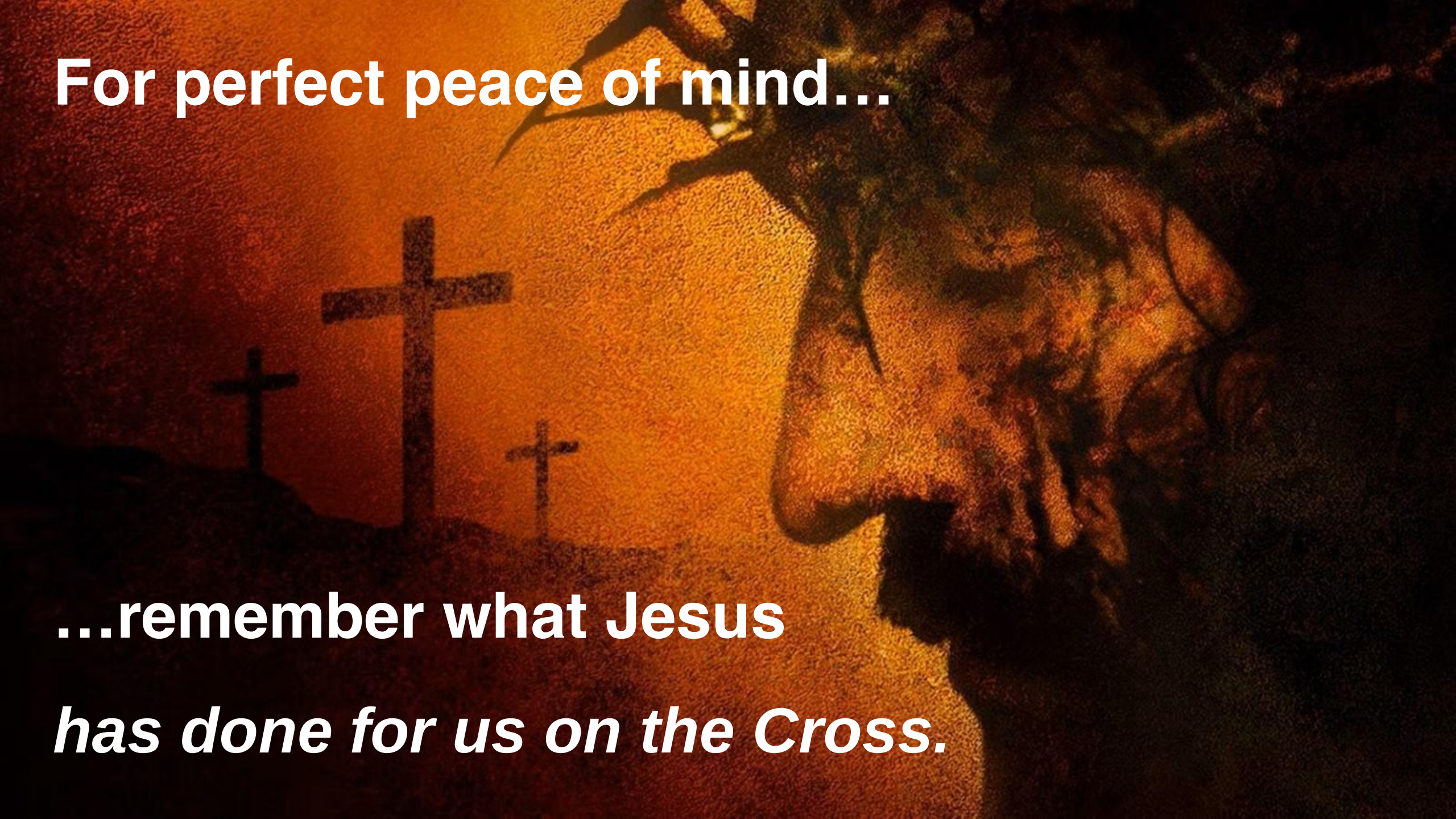


3. *Renew*
